With a rich military history there are plenty of things to see, hop in a 4x4 Jeep and take a tour around the island to see the WWII abandoned tunnels, ex Yugoslavia President's Tito's hiding place or for the experienced divers there are plenty of underwater plane and shipwrecks sites surrounding the island.

From the crystal clear waters of the blue caves, the adorable fishing village of Komiza to the best view of the island at 587m on Mount Hum - Vis is certain to leave memories that last a lifetime.

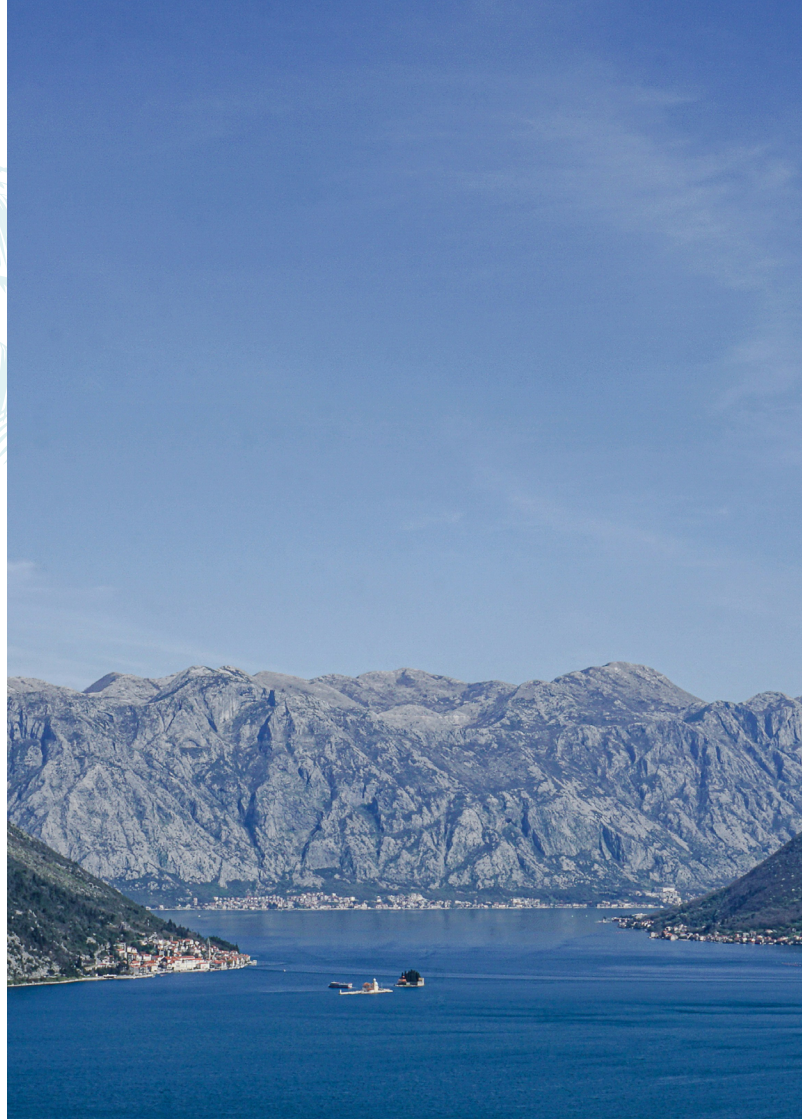
